

The 2022 Welsh Mountain Sheep Society Open Day will be held under the auspices of the Meirion branch in Cae Poeth, Cwm Cynllwyd, Llanuwchllyn, Bala, on Saturday **1st October 2022 at 1:00pm**, courtesy of Glyn and Awena.



The sharing of vehicles should be attempted where appropriate as the road and access to the location is very limited. To reach Cae Poeth you will have to pass through the village of Llanuwchllyn, over a bridge towards Dinas Mawddwy. There will be signs on the road for you to follow and we ask everyone to park on the Rhyd-y-Bod farm fields (with thanks for their permission). You will have to walk down the field to the small bridge over the river Twrch and walk up towards the Cae Poeth yard. If this is a problem it will be possible to get transport from the field to the yard using an appropriate vehicle.


Cae Poeth is a 215 acer farm starting at 800ft above sea level and rising to 2000 feet. There are 260 ewes and 80 yearlings. Lambing percentage was 150% for last season. All ewes in the flock are put to a Welsh Mountain ram and 50 acers is grassland and the rest is unimproved habitat land. There are 6 rams in the flock and the whole flock is part of the Hybu Cig Cymru EBV scheme. The flock will be shown in the surrounding fields and also in the sheds. Light refreshments will be provided by Cig Oen Aran.
